



General Information for Coaches

- Saturday morning: there will be a meeting for all team coaches at the centre at **8:30am** where final information will be given and changing rooms assigned.
- Schedules for the tournaments will be confirmed at the introductory meeting.

EQUIPMENT AND THINGS TO BRING

- All players **must** wear shin pads.
- GIRLS: Play on second generation astro-turf so we recommend 5-a-side shoes (artificial surface shoes), but boots can be worn with moulded studs (13) or blades.
- BOYS: Play on new generation astro-turf so all footwear apart from screw in studs is allowed.
- We recommend all teams bring their own water bottles with them to the event.
- Sunscreen and hats are essential for all players and coaches.
- Each team must bring either a change of shirts or bibs in case of colour clash.
- **Please come with photocopies of your squad lists**
- Squads must remain the same for each session (Saturday and Sunday).

GENERAL CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR

- Please ensure that you set the example and encourage players to respect referees and accept decisions. Referees have been told not to tolerate dissent or violent behaviour.
- Only team members and coaches are allowed inside the fence whilst games are in progress. There is a stand area for spectators.
- Please encourage your players to make this a non-smoking tournament. Obviously, no smoking is allowed in the playing areas. Please ask those that must smoke to leave the facility to do so.
- We ask that you arrive at your pitch 10 minutes before your kick off time in order to stay on schedule.
